RECENT ACQUISITIONS

City Union Mission, Kansas City's oldest "rescue mission" for men, women and families, once operated out of three former downtown brothels at 4th and Wyandotte Streets.

Mission founders Rev. David and Beulah Bulkley were neighbors of well-known 'madame' Annie Chambers. Deeply affected by their compassionate message, Miss Chambers became their close friend, and upon her death left her estate to help continue the Mission's work. The estate included a dresser, shown. It is a beautiful example of the Charles Eastlake school and was most likely made c. 1875-1890. Kansas City Museum is honored to be chosen by City Union Mission as a "partner in preservation" of this important artifact documenting a colorful period of our city's history. The dresser and the Mission are featured in the June 2011 Community Curator lecture.

You'll enjoy a leisurely 100-mile ride through beautiful Missouri countryside with stops at some of the region's historically significant spots: Fort Osage, Lexington, Missouri Civil War battlefield, Lone Jack, Missouri and the historic Rice-Tremonti Home.
